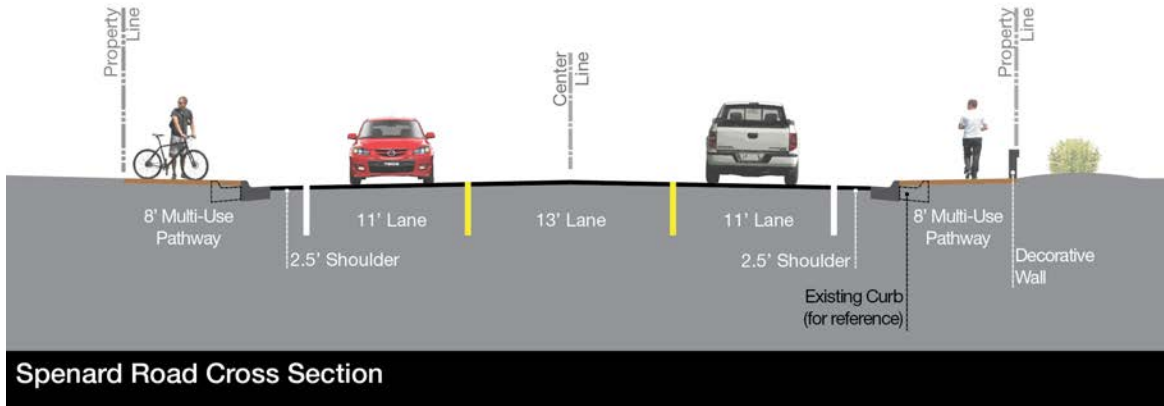
SPENARD ROAD Reconstruction



Project Scope

Spenard Road between Hillcrest Drive and Benson Boulevard (30th Avenue) is a Minor Arterial roadway. The proposed project will convert the existing 4-lane section to a 3-lane section with a two-way center left turn lane. This conversion will enhance corridor safety and reallocate portions of right-of-way to make room for ADA compliant multi-use pathways and bicycle facilities that meet current design criteria and local planning documents. The proposed design would also update the roadway lighting, add parking facilities and bring bus stops up to current standards. The design cross section (shown below) has been selected. The proposed preliminary design is shown on the back of this sheet.

The draft Design Study Report was recently completed and is available for review and comment. Once the report is finalized, detailed design work and right-of-way acquisition will continue. Funding for construction is included on the April 2016 Municipal Bond ballot for \$13.8M. Voter approval of the bonds will allow the project to be constructed in 2017.
