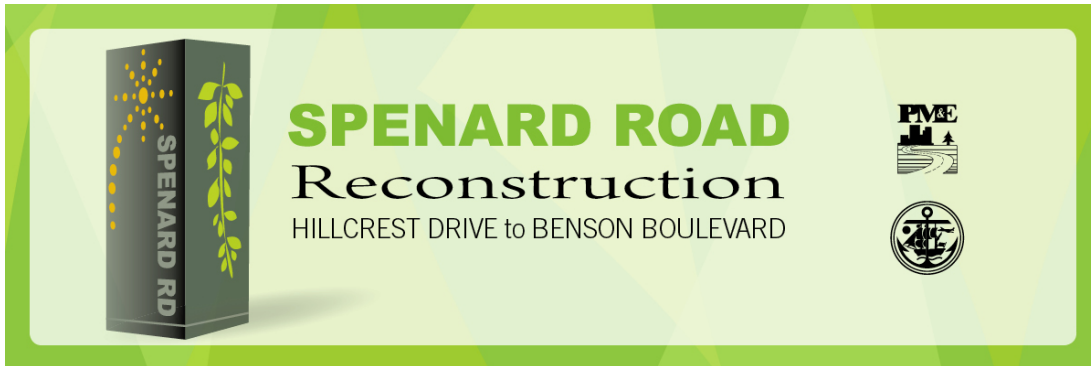

Thursday, October 5 Weekly Update

- 23rd Avenue will be closed at Spenard Road for approximately one more week to facilitate the installation of an oil and grit separator and associated storm drain work.
- All of the remaining curb and gutter has been placed and the final section of Spenard Road will be paved within the next week as weather allows.
- The project office is located at the old SkiAK building, between Benson Boulevard and 30th Avenue. **A PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE will be held biweekly at this location, with the next meeting held on Wednesday, October 11 from 10:00am to 11:00am.**
- Typical construction schedule: 7 days a week, from 7:00am to 6:00pm. Hours may vary depending on weather and specific work taking place.
- We understand the inconvenience and disruption that a road improvement project imposes on neighborhood residents and businesses, and hope the quality and convenience of the new road will outweigh the sacrifices required along the way. The project team again wishes to thank you for your patience during these times.

Planned Construction:

The Municipality of Anchorage is working with QAP to reconstruct Spenard Road, from Hillcrest Drive to Benson Boulevard. Improvements include new asphalt, curbs, sidewalks, bike lanes, ADA ramp upgrades, realignment of the 27th Avenue intersection, new traffic signals at Fireweed Lane, Benson Boulevard and Northern Lights Boulevard, new LED street lights, as well as street scaping and landscaping improvements. This project will be under construction throughout 2017.
